



Flies looking to be a problem this summer.

With summer on our doorstep and talk of a wet summer, it's a good time to review your fly strike prevention and treatment plan in terms of a chemical strategy.

A great tool for farmers is the Flyboss website (www.flyboss.com.au). Not only will it help coming into summer, but also help you to start thinking about the plan for the following year.

Options to think about for prevention and treatment are:

CLiK EXTRA contains 65g/L Dicyclanil and provides protection for 29 weeks and can be used on any length of wool from 4 weeks after shearing.

Covine Clipshield contains 60g/L Cyromazine and will provide protection for eleven weeks and can be used on any length of wool.

Extinosad Lice, Fly and Maggot Eliminator contains 25g/L Spinosad and will provide treatment to already struck sheep and protection for 8 days after treatment of the wound or 4-6 weeks via jetting application in long wool sheep.

Extinosad Aerosol for wounds comes in a 370g can and contains 2.80g/kg Spinosad and 0.39g/kg Chlorhexidine Digluconate. Product to be applied to wound site which will end in the rapid knockdown of maggots and provide an antiseptic to the wound site.
